Dear Ms Mikkelson:

As Chief of the Nisichawayasihk Cree Nation, I am writing to express concern about the way you have used my name to lend credibility to your movie, Green Green Water by adding the following inaccurate reference: "24 August, 2006- Jim Moore, a vocal opponent of the Wuskwatim (sic), beat all three in the election."

In addition, it is my understanding that in documentation and presentations related to the film, I am also referred to as a vocal opponent of the Wuskwatim Project with the inference that I was elected chief because of that.

I am not an opponent of the Wuskwatim Project and do not wish to be referred to in this manner. In fact, I was an early supporter of the project. As an active participant in our First Nation I have expressed my views and opinions about how the project might go forward throughout the Wuskwatim negotiating process, as many of our people did.

As you know, a majority of my people voted in favour of proceeding with the project last year and the Project Development Agreement was signed in June 2006. Construction on the project started in August last summer after the signing of a historic Heritage Resources Agreement.

During the NCN election process last summer, I indicated very clearly that I would honour the vote by my people and that I had no intention of renegotiating the Wuskwatim Project Development Agreement.

My Council and I believe that sustainable economic development like Wuskwatim is important to the future success of our young and quickly growing community. Since the election we have been working to ensure our people realize maximum benefits from this project. To date, approximately 75 percent of the people employed on the project are Aboriginal people, most of whom are NCN Members. We believe this project will realize significant benefits for our people and that it can, in fact, help heal the wounds from developments of the past.

To this end, I expect you to add a statement to your website (www.greengreenwater.com) to make it clear that I am not an opponent of Wuskwatim, as I have set out in this letter.

In addition, I expect that whenever you or anyone introduce the film that it be made clear the film does not accurately state my position about the Wuskwatim Project, and that you then state my position accurately. If a re-edited version of the film is ever produced and distributed, I expect correct information on my position to be included in the revised version.

Furthermore, I expect other statements you may attribute to me and to Nisichawayasihk Cree Nation to be accurate, up-to-date and balanced.
